



Dear parents

The shutdown of all day care institutions have been extended until April 13 (including this day). Therefore, the emergency day care continues with the same procedures and criteria as previously. Criteria and procedures are as described:

Mariagerfjord Kommune offers emergency day care for children whose parents perform critical duties in the public or private sector or parents who are unable to find other solutions for caretaking of their children.

If you need emergency day care, you need to contact the day care leader through FAMILY as soon as the need arises.

Please include the following information:

- Name and age of the child
- Current day care institution
- Current need for day care – please note which day(s) and times
- Description of your need for day care (see criteria below)

There are a set of criteria that are to be met in order to be able to obtain emergency day care:

Both parents/the single provider are employed in the health sector, in the elderly or nursing sector, at the Police, at the Prison Service, at the Emergency Management, at the meat inspection or within the area of socially marginalized people.

It is not a criterion for emergency day care, if one parent is ordered to work from home.

We will contact you, as soon as we know the extent of the need for emergency day care in regards to where the day care will be placed geographically.

If a need arises in the coming weeks, you are asked to contact the day care leader. We ask you to do the same, if your need for emergency day care changes or stops.

In regards to the need for day care, we kindly inform you, that grandparents should not take care of children, if they due to age or health conditions are specifically vulnerable to COVID-19.

If you choose to cooperate with other parents in regards to the caretaking of your children, we recommend that no more than five children are placed at the same location.
