

# A guide to sorting your waste



## General waste

- Diapers, sanitary pads and cotton swabs
- Contaminated packing
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Pizza boxes
- Wrappers from snacks
- Baking paper



Put the waste in a bag and tie with a knot.

## Glass

- Glass bottles from spirits, dressing and fruit juice
- Empty food jars
- Marmelade and Jam glasses
- Wine bottles



Empty glass and bottles must be handed in glass cubes or at the recycling centers.

## Paper

- Newspapers and magazines
- Brochures
- Letters and envelopes
- Books without spines
- Bags of paper
- Clean paper in general



Must be clean and dry. Place loose in the container.

## Food waste

- Cheese and dairy products
- Tea bags and coffee filters with grounds
- Fish, meat, toppings and bones
- Vegetables and fruit
- Bread, cakes, rice, pasta and sauce
- Bouquet of flowers



Put the waste in a bag and tie with a knot.

## Metal

- Tins from beer and soft drinks
- Aluminum trays and foil
- Food tins
- Used tealight holders
- Metal lids



Place the empty packaging loose in the container.

## Cardboard

- Cardboard tubes from toilet paper
- Small cardboard boxes
- Egg boxes
- Corrugated cardboard
- Shoe boxes



Must be clean and dry. Place loose in the container.

## Food- & drink cartons

- Empty cartons from milk, juice and beans
- Empty food cartons i.e. from soup, yoghurt, creme and ice cream
- Cardboard mugs



Place the empty packaging loose in the container.

## Plastic

- Plastic bags, plastic foil and bubble wrap
- Toys without batteries
- Plastic service
- Plastic trays



Place the empty packaging loose in the container.

## Hazardous waste

- Small electronic devices
- Nail polish- and remover
- Paint and oil residues
- Spray bottles
- Batteries
- Chemicals
- Thermometers
- Light bulbs



Place in the red environmental box.

## To be delivered at the recycling centers

- White goods
- Furniture
- Carpets
- Garden waste
- Mattresses
- Electronics
- Textile waste
- Cardboard
- Flamingo
- Bicycles
